Regarding Administrators Who May Attend and Vote in Faculty Meetings

Motion:

The Committee on Faculty Governance moves that the words "The Dayton Director of the Tang Teaching Museum and Art Gallery" be inserted in administrators who may attend and vote inculty meetings. The fully amended text, with the new language in boldface, would appear as follows:

Part One, Section XIX, p. 137:

All the faculty as herein defined approached to attend Faculty Meetings and are eligible to vote: all full-tienmembers of theaculty and faculty holding shared appointments at the rap fassistant professor or above, visiting instructors, librarians, artise fin-residence, and full-year full-time lecturers, the President, the Vice Rolest for Academic Affairs and Dean of the Faculty, the Dean of Admissis and Financial Aid, the Associate Dean of the Faculty, the Dean of Student Affairs, the Dean of Studies, the Dean of Special Programs, the Registrar and Director of Institutional Research, the Senior Associate Diocect Admissions, the Director of University Without Walls, the Director of Master of Arts in Liberal Studies, the Director of the Tang Teaching Museum and Art Gallery and such other administrative officers may be appointed to the Faculty by the Board of Trustees upon recommendation of the President after consultation with the CAPT and with the concurrence of the Faculty.

Part Two, Section I, Aircle I (C)(c), p. 202:

the President, the Vice President for Academic Affairs and Dean of the Faculty, the Dean of Admissions and Fincial Aid, the Associate Dean of Faculty, the Dean of Student Affairts, Dean of Studies, the Dean of Special Programs, the Registrar and Director of Institutional Research, the Senior Associate Director of Admiss, the Director of University Without Walls, the Director of Master of Arts in Liberal Studies, the Director of Summer Sessions Summer Special Progrants Dayton Director of the Tang Teaching Museum and Art Gallery,

The Dayton Director of the Tang Teaching Musseand Art Gallery is an administrative position leading a museum that reachestout the campus community in the broadest terms. The Director therefore is responsible curriculum, the stdents and the faculty in all that the museum undertakes and must closely with faculty, collaborating to ensure that the museum serves its purposetofely, while also repring to the Dean of the Faculty.
