## MOTION

On behalf of the Office of Off-Campus Study & Exchanges, the Advisory Committee on Off-Campus Study, the Dean of the Faculty's office and the department of Foreign Languages and Literatures, CEPP proposes that Skidmore College terminate the Skidmore in China program and, as a result, its affiliation with IES in China.

## Rationale:

A comprehensive review of the program found that it had the following weaknesses:

There is a lack of sufficient and sustained student interest in the program. Maintaining a Skidmore program in China has proven more expensive than it will be to utilize existing programs through other schools and providers.
