On February 7th, the Honors Forum hosted a dialogue entitled "Do We Really Have a Climate Crisis and Can It Be Solved: A Conversation on the Future of the Climate and Humanity Response." The event, held in the Cornell Auditorium from 5:00-6:30pm, was moderated by Prof. Kristofer Covey of the Studies I. The event was organized by the HF Executive Committee Vice President. The debate featured two noteworthy speakers: Orrin G. Hatch, a senior advisor to the 2016 presidential campaign, and Andrew Revkin, a senior advisor for Environmental and Science Journalism for the National Geographic Society.



The event kicked off with both speakers and moderators. Tackling the debate respectfully from two different sides, Cass and Revkin set the tone for a civil and good-spirited, informed conversation in the name of solutions and engagement with issues related to climate change. From there, the night's moderators moved the talk toward topics like the Paris Agreement, the science and economic implications of climate change, and the role of environmental issues. The event concluded with an open question and answer portion featuring students and members of the community.
